Doctors

Gateway Health Medical Practices are located in Wangaratta and Wodonga. Offering a range of services by male and female doctors including general health, family and children's health, immunisations, mental health, sexual health, womens wellness, refugee health, chronic disease management, Hep C, HIV and more. Bulk billing is available.

McGrath Breast Care Nurse

If you have been diagnosed with primary or secondary breast cancer, this program can give you and your family support and education in conjunction with Oncologists.

Men's Behaviour Change
