



Neuro Support Group

The Neuro Support Group is a social group for people with a neurological condition and their carers.

What happens at the group?

People get the opportunity to share their life experiences and develop friendships while enjoying a range of activities. The group visits local attractions; enjoy supported recreational pursuits and learn more about areas of interest in relation to living with a neurological condition.

Do I need to have a Carer?

If you have support needs in relation to personal care and mobility you will be asked to have a carer attend. This can be a friend, family member or a paid carer.

Is there transport available?

Your transport needs will be discussed with you when you register. We do have access to vehicles with wheelchair access for outings but our capacity is limited.

Is there a cost?

The cost will vary depending on the event.

Group locations and times:

The group meets on the first Wednesday of the month (approximately 8 occasions over the year). Locations will vary depending upon the planned event.
