Clinic 35 is a sexual and reproductive health service that offers clients a confidential and safe setting in which to discuss sexual health concerns and receive specialist sexual and reproductive health care. Our clinic focuses on the more vulnerable and under-screened groups in the community, such as young people.

Who listens to you at Clinic 35?

When you visit Clinic 35, you will be assessed by a registered nurse with specialised training in sexual and reproductive health. They can help you decide the best service for your needs. In some cases the Nurse may refer you to see your own GP, or alternatively refer you to other specialist services including our GP Service.



Opening Hours: 9am - 5pm, Monday to Friday. If you want to see the Nurse at Clinic 35 you can phone ahead to make an appointment or you can walk in and wait to be seen.

Costs: There is no cost to attend Clinic 35, it is a FREE health service. Our GP may provide you with a prescription for some medications. You will need to get any prescriptions filled at your local pharmacy at your cost.
