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Who's eligible?

- Children 0–12 years requiring support with social, emotional or behavioural challenges.
- Children must have a parent or significant other willing to be involved and provide consent.
- Children or families do not require a diagnosis to be eligible for support.

How do we support?

- 1. Intensive, long term, early intervention support for children and their families.
- 2. Short-term assistance for families which includes assessment of needs, provision of information or referrals.
- 3. Community outreach, mental health education and community development activities.

What do we offer?

- Group work, art therapy, parenting support and programs, mindfulness strategies, drumming groups, and holiday programs.
- Case management: Long or short term.
- Community education, information for parents and schools, and mental health education.
- Supportive one to one counselling with children.
- Practical assistance and home based support.

 Self referrals are welcome and all referrals will be managed by the CHIPS coordinator.
