

SHARED CARE:

Shared care is Antenatal care provided by your GP and Northeast Health Wangaratta Antenatal clinic. In shared care your GP will provide most of your antenatal care.

You will have antenatal clinic appointments at weeks **12-14, 20, 28, 36, 40** and **41**. Sometimes more antenatal clinic appointments may be needed.



MIDWIFERY GROUP PRACTICE (MGP):

MGP care is provided by a small team of six midwives – with one midwife allocated to be your primary caregiver.

MGP care is available if you have an uncomplicated medical history and pregnancy.



DOMICILIARY MIDWIFE:

The Domiciliary Midwife will visit you whilst you are in hospital after the birth of your baby. This visit is to plan and prepare for when you go home.

The Domiciliary Midwife then provides postnatal visits in your home.
