Surgical Abortion Service

Albury Wodonga Health provides a surgical abortion service for women between **7 - 12 weeks** of pregnancy, at no cost. Albury Wodonga Health (AWH) have a fortnightly theatre schedule and the AWH Choices Pre-Admission Clinic will see all patients for the pre-admission process.

The requirements for the referral to be processed are:

- Referral letter to be emailed to above email address to AWH Choices Pre-Admission Clinic please ensure medications, past history and allergies are up-to-date
- Blood investigations: Quantitative BHCG, FBE, Blood Group and Antibodies, Fe Studies
- Pelvic Ultrasound Ordered: For confirmation of intra-uterine pregnancy please add "considering termination of pregnancy" as this allows radiology to triage for patients seeking a more urgent appointment
- Self-collected vaginal swabs: Chlamydia MC&S (if indicated)

ALL PATHOLOGY to be copied to 'Wodonga Maternity'

NOTE: referrals will be returned and not processed if the above results are not provided.

Contraception options - Long-acting reversible contraception such as a contraceptive implant (Implanon) or Intra Uterine Device (IUD) are reliable and cost-effective. These can be fitted during a surgical abortion procedure. Other hormonal methods, such as "the pill" can be started the day after a surgical abortion.

Once the referral has been received, the nurse will contact the patient for an appointment to ensure all pre-admission forms (RFAs) are completed.
